This new dual-compound sport's tyre replaces the Pilot Power and the Pilot Power 2CT. By using Kevlar belting, they have managed to lighten the tyre by almost a Kg to reduce unsprung weight and improve rider safety and handling. The softer shoulder compound comes into play much earlier in the lean angle than it did in the previous PP 2CT.

These tyres will be hitting my racks before lunch tomorrow, and we're offering a sweetener for the first 20 sets sold, so get in early!
